The Burnaby School District is proud to offer students safe and caring schools. To continue to maintain quality of our schools and ensure your success in our International Student Program, we require you to abide by our Code of Conduct set out below:

**Within school and in the community, I will:**

- abide by the laws of Canada and my home country.
- abide by the rules of my host school.
- not participate in any acts of violence.
- respect property of others.
- refuse to buy, sell or use drugs or alcohol.
- not purchase, use or have in my possession any weapons or dangerous implements.
- respect cultural and individual differences.
- attend classes and not incur unexcused absences.
- attend classes on time.
- avoid disturbing classes.
- be co-operative and prepared to work.
- complete assignments on time.
- practice academic honesty.

**I understand that:**

- I cannot possess any special learning needs.
- I cannot be failing courses and must maintain a minimum "C" average in order to remain in the program.
- I am not permitted to live on my own and that I must be supervised and living with an adult 25 years of age or older.
- I will inform the school of any absences. For any planned absences (e.g. return to home country), I will ensure that I will not miss an extended number of classes or depart before the end of the official school year/semester.
- If there are any changes to my living situation, for example, my address or custodianship, I will immediately notify the school I am attending and the International Student Education Office.
- I am to act as a polite and proper representative of the Burnaby School District's International Student Program and my host school.
- I am not permitted to drive/operate a vehicle in Canada as long as I am a student in Burnaby's ISP.
